



What is the GEOMARKER and How Can I Turn It Off?

Issue

You open a drawing or create a new drawing and see a white dot in the center of the drawing. When you plot this white dot appears on the plotted sheet. What is this thing and how can I get rid of it?

Solution

This white dot is called the **GEOMARKER**. Essentially, it is the placeholder for the assigned geographic coordinate system. The **GEOMARKER**'s visibility is controlled by the **GEOMARKERVISIBILITY** variable.

To alter this variable enter **GEOMARKERVISIBILITY** on the command line

When prompted enter a value for the variable as follows:

- 1 to display the graphic
- 0 to prevent the graphic from being displayed
